Description of Environmental Care Analysis of Students in Elementary Schools

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ABSTRACT

Purpose of the study: This study aims to describe the environmental care character of students at the elementary school level.

Methodology: This research is a qualitative research with a systematic literature review type. The data in this study is secondary data in the form of research results documents related to this research. The population in this study was obtained from the Google Scholar site with the selected article criteria related to the search keywords. The total population obtained is 25 articles from Google Scholar.

Main Findings: The main findings explain the important factors in instilling the Caring for the Environment character in elementary school students. By caring for the environment students can recognize the types of waste according to their group. The impact caused by students besides making students comfortable learning also helps students get used to living healthy and clean.

Novelty/Originality of this study: This research seeks to describe the character of caring for the environment through literature studies from previous studies on the character of caring for the environment in elementary schools.

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1. INTRODUCTION

Education is the most important thing in our lives, this means that every Indonesian has the right to get it and is expected to always develop in it [1]–[3]. Education will never end. Education in general means a life process in developing each individual to be able to live and live life. So being an educated person is very important. We are educated to be people who are useful both for the State, the Homeland and the Nation [4]–[6]. The first education we get is in the family environment (Informal Education), the school environment (Formal Education), and the community environment (Non-formal Education)). Informal education is education that a person obtains from everyday experiences, consciously or unconsciously, from birth to death. This educational process lasts a lifetime [7]–[9]. So the role of the family is very important for children, especially parents.

Elementary school education also has the same meaning as the explanation described above, but there are differences from the audience, namely elementary grades 1 to 6 whose material provisions and subject matter are regulated in the GBPP (Outlines of the Teaching Program) [10]–[12]. The purpose of elementary school education itself is to lay the basic intelligence, knowledge, personality, noble character, and skills to live independently and follow further education. In addition, the existence of this basic education can make a child form individuals who are able to live in groups. There are several functions of basic education as a reference

before moving on to the next level of education, because if the basic education level is not enough attention, then of course going to the next level will also be difficult and not good enough [13]–[15].

The educational process is inseparable from the environment, the educational process and the environment have a close and inseparable relationship [16]–[18]. Problems in the environment that occur today cannot be separated from human behavior because the environment and humans live side by side. Humans are considered as selfish individuals because they only think about their interests without paying attention to environmental sustainability. Activities exploiting the environment indicate that human concern for the surrounding environment has been lost which will have a major impact on human life itself [18]. This can be seen from the smallest thing, namely the difficulty of the human habit of disposing of waste in its place.

Character education is education that teaches ways of thinking and behaving that are characteristic of each individual in society and the country [19] To make people aware of the importance of preserving a good environment can be done by providing knowledge and instilling character through education. Character education must be instilled from an early age, especially at the elementary school level as a place of education which is the basis for forming children's character towards caring for the environment around [20]. The formation of the character of caring for the environment is instilled through education in schools during the learning process and through daily habits carried out by the teacher as the prime mover and implemented by students. There are four ways of implementing environmental care character education in elementary schools, including through routine habituation activities, spontaneous habituation activities, exemplary habituation activities, conditioning.

2. RESEARCH METHOD

This research focuses on the character of caring for the environment in students at the elementary level. This research is a qualitative research with a systematic literature review type [21]. Systematic Literature Review (hereinafter shortened to Systematic Review-TS) is a written assessment of scientific publications with methods that have been established and recognized by the research community to achieve the target of identification, analysis, interpretation of all available evidence in order to answer certain research questions, where methods and the results of the assessment are explained in a structured and sequential manner, and are open to receiving comments and further elaboration. The data in this study is secondary data in the form of research results documents related to this research. The population in this study was obtained from the Google Scholar site with the selected article criteria related to the search keywords. The total population obtained is 25 articles from Google Scholar.

The flow of research conducted as follows.




Figure 1. Data collection flow

The above flow chart is explained in detail as follows:

- 1. Define keywords for the main search.
- 2. Searching for literature on Google Scholar with the keyword "Caring for the environment in Elementary Schools" spanning 2012 to 2023.
- 3. The selected articles are articles related to keywords with the subject of research by elementary school students
- 4. Articles obtained on Google Scholar are filtered again with the criteria for selected articles to be study articles from Sinta 1 to Sinta 6 indexed journals.

Conduct a review by reading the title, abstract of the article on the research topic. After the articles that will be used as references are collected, the researcher conducts a review with several criteria shown in the descriptive statistics table.

3. RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

The review process is carried out on scientific articles that are selected for their reputation based on the topics studied. Environmental care character of elementary school students. The number of articles reviewed is as much 25 pieces. Following are the results of a review of articles about this research:

Following are the results of a review of articles about this research: Overall, previous researchers, limited the evaluation of the scope of learning to four major components, among others; (1) character education, (2) character care for the environment, (3) environmental character assessment for elementary school students, and in this article the character cares for the environment for elementary school students only focuses on the scope of the domain of learning outcomes with a sample of elementary school students (SD).

Based on the results of the analysis of 25 articles, the results of the discussion analysis are:

a. Environmental care character of elementary school students

In the analysis of a review of 25 articles regarding caring for the environment for elementary school students, the formation of the character of caring for the environment for students uses a good strategy and is in accordance with the indicators which are used as a reference in research. Character education is very closely related to habits that are continuously practiced or carried out, in the sense that character education is expected to touch all three domains (cognitive, affective and psychomotor) [22]. One of the factors that influence the formation of environmental care character through science learning is teaching materials. In this case, the teacher's efforts in planning learning are in the form of compiling teaching tools such as syllabus, Learning Implementation Plans (RPP) and learning media, these tools have been analyzed beforehand by the teacher regarding the value contained in the material to be taught [23]. The lack of concern for the environment at the elementary school level is due to the lack of participation of teachers and parents in character building. So that the school community should try to implement an environmentally sound school curriculum, in the learning process by utilizing the school environment.

b. Environmental care character assessment of students

Assessment of students' environmental care character from the results of the article review explained that there were 92 percent explaining that students had good environmental care. This happens because there are several applications of environmental care carried out in learning. Applications are carried out such as mutual cooperation activities, disposing of garbage, planting plants and paying attention to the form of waste when disposing of garbage. There were 8 percent who explained that students at the elementary school level still had low awareness of caring for the environment [24]. This is due to the lack of learning that is environmentally clean. The lack of participation of school principals is also a factor in low environmental awareness.

c. The impact of the character of caring for the environment of students

The character of caring for the environment in elementary school students has an impact both in the long term and in the short term [25]. In the long term students can apply a clean life within themselves, students can get used to always keeping the environment clean and teach students the importance of mutual cooperation in cleaning the environment. Caring for the environment is carried out in order to create a clean and healthy environment so that residents or students who study and live there feel comfortable and peaceful [26]. The short-term impact carried out by students is that students know the types of waste that are disposed of according to the type. In addition, students are protected from mosquito bites or animals that can carry disease, which makes students study comfortably and focus on learning.

4. CONCLUSION

The analysis of 25 review articles explains the important factors in cultivating the character of Caring for the Environment in elementary school level students. By caring for the environment students can recognize the types of waste according to their group. There are several schools that are still low on environmental care for students. This is because teachers, principals and parents do not participate in implementing environmental care. The impact caused by students besides making students comfortable learning also helps students get used to living a healthy and clean life.

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
